Covid-19 update

An update from Public Health England and Newcastle City Council

Public Health teams from Newcastle City Council and Public Health England are working to detect further cases of COVID-19, limit its onward spread and reduce the impact it may have on local communities.

We would therefore advise that schools inform any close contacts of a positive case to take a PCR test before the end of their period of self-isolation. They should do this even if they have returned a negative Lateral Flow Device (LFD) test during the period of their self-isolation. This additional testing will help to reduce any possible transmission within the school. This highly precautionary approach will allow us to detect any additional cases within the wider community and reduce possible transmission.

This means that if you or your child have to isolate as a close contact, you should take a PCR test before the end of your isolation period.

Sports Day

We are working hard to make Sports Day work and are always working within COVID restrictions and would like your support. We are changing plans again due to most recent guidance and would love you to be able to see Sports Day. We know this is going to be an inconvenience if you have more than one child across school however we are trying our best so that as many parents and carers as possible can attend. If guidelines change again, we will keep you as up to date as possible.

Please see the timetable for each class attached.

Each child will be able to have an adult to watch them and sit in a designated seating area. There will be permitted times to enter and leave the seating zone (maximum 30 seats in one area) to comply with all COVID regulations.

What this means for you as a parent or carer, is that one adult for each child will be able to attend within the rule of 30 but we know that you may be attending more than one session, there is nothing we can do about that and you will need to leave the school site between sessions. No other siblings will be allowed apart from young children not of school age and this will count as two spaces. You will need to follow COVID guidelines in terms of social distancing and the rule of 30. You will be provided with a ticket for Sports Day closer to the time. If you are unable to attend, videos and photos will be posted on Class Dojo throughout the sessions.
